



## The People...

- "Be Holy for I am Holy" (Lev. 11:44-45)
- Israel's being set apart to God <u>physically</u> was supposed to represent <u>hearts</u> that were set apart to God spiritually. (Lev. 20:24-26; 26)
  - Symbolic message: "Being in relationship with God affects
     <u>every</u> <u>area</u> of life." (1 Cor. 10:31)

### The Priest...

- Priests declared people clean/unclean and made <u>sacrifices</u>.
  - O Symbolic message of sacrifice: "When you sin, either you die or something dies in your <u>place</u>."
- On the Day of Atonement (*Yom Kippur*) the <u>high</u> priest made atonement for the sin of the nation. (Lev. 16)
  - o Symbolic Message of the Priest: "You need the work of someone else to fix your brokenness."
- Jesus is our high <u>priest</u>. (Heb. 10:11-18)
- Jesus is the final <u>sacrifice</u>. (Heb. 10:11-18)
- Through the Spirit, every believer is now a priest. (1 Pet. 2:9)
  - o We have access to God's <u>presence</u>. (Heb. 10:19)
  - o We make spiritual <u>sacrifices</u>. (1 Pet. 2:4-5)
  - o We proclaim God's **glory** . (1 Pet. 2:9)
