## Three Encouragements...

- God often chooses to display his glory through the \_\_\_\_\_ of his people. (Josh. 6; 2 Cor. 12:9-10)
  - Military battles were interpreted \_\_\_\_\_.
    - “But he said to me, ‘My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.’ Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong.” (2 Cor. 12:9-10)
- God develops our faith through \_\_\_\_\_ means. (Josh. 6:1-5; 2 Cor. 1:8-10)
  - Often times, God is not as interested in changing your \_\_\_\_\_ as He is in changing \_\_\_\_\_ through them.
- God’s promises and \_\_\_\_\_ give us strength when we don’t understand His \_\_\_\_\_. (Josh 5:13-6:2; Ps. 119:50)

    - Is your faithfulness to God only as good as the results you’re able to see? (Hab. 3:17-19)
