DISCOVERING GOD'S WILL FOR YOUR LIFE

#### God's Two Wills...

- Revealed will: the cosmic state of affairs as it *should* be
  - O Does *not* always come to pass (Ex. 23:7; 2 Pet. 3:9)
- <u>Sovereign</u> will: the cosmic state of affairs God brings to pass
  - o Always comes to pass (Acts 4:26-28; Eph. 1:11)
    - "The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but the things that are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law." (Deut. 29:29)

### God's Will and God's Word...

- Discerning God's will is not a matter of discovering the <u>future</u> ahead of time, but of applying all that God *has* revealed in Scripture to our <u>circumstances</u>.
   God's Word gives <u>direction</u>, not details. (Ps. 119:105)
   God's Word is <u>enough</u> (2 Tim. 3:16)
   Don't rely on special "signs" or feelings.
  - God Himself is our <u>hope</u>. (Isa. 43:2-3)

## God's Will For Our Lives...

- Seek His <u>kingdom</u> and His <u>righteousness</u> (Mt. 6:33) ○ "all these things" ≠ our <u>goals</u>. (Hos. 1, 3)
  - o Seeking God's kingdom  $\neq$  <u>immediate</u> happiness.

### God's Will For Your Life...

- Meditate on the <u>Word</u>. (2 Tim. 3:16)
- Pray earnestly. (Js. 1:5)
- Consider your <u>gifts</u> and desires. (Ex. 36:2)
- Seek <u>godly</u> counsel. (Prov. 11:14, 15:22)
- Just <u>do</u> something. (Ps. 37:5)
- <u>Trust</u> in God's sovereign goodness.
